Professor Simon Lewis is an NHMRC-ARC Dementia Fellow who is Professor of Cognitive Neuroscience at the University of Sydney. He is the Clinical Director of the Ageing Brain Clinic and Director of the Parkinson's Disease Research Clinic at the Brain & Mind Centre and heads the NSW Movement Disorders Brain Donor program. He has published over 200 peer review papers, 2 books and 7 book chapters and has attracted over \$5 Million in funding from various sources including the NHMRC, ARC and Michael J Fox Foundation to support his research interests targeting quality of life in neurodegenerative diseases.

## FAQs

### **I'm a member of PACT. Do I have to register?**

Yes PACT members must register (on Eventbrite purchase a Free Ticket) for seating and catering purposes.

### **I'm a member of PACT. How many free tickets can I register for?**

PACT members are entitled to register for two free tickets if their membership lists a second person (for example, a carer).

### **Will refreshments be provided and is it included in the ticket?**

Yes – participants will be provided with a light lunch (sandwiches and fresh fruit) on arrival. Water, tea and coffee will also be available.

### **What if I have food intolerances?**

Please advise of your dietary requirements when registering on Eventbrite so that the caterers can ensure there is suitable food available for you on the day.

### **Is the venue accessible for people with disability?**

Yes, the Southern Cross Club is fully accessible for people using mobility aids and has accessible toilets immediately outside of the forum room.

There are also a number of quiet spaces where participants can relax as needed.

### **What are my transport/parking options for getting to and from the event?**

There is plenty of secure, free under-cover parking at the club, including a number of disabled parking spots near main entrances. Participants will need to have their parking tickets validated at the main desk in the foyer before departing. There is also plenty of public parking directly across the road from the venue and in the immediate vicinity.
